2. Abstracts should not contain more than 250 words

3. The abstracts should contain: the purpose, methods, results and the conclusion.

4. The selected abstracts will be published at the Abstract book

THE SPEAKER GUIDELINES:

Guest lectures - 20 minutes.

The oral presentations: 8 minutes + 2 minutes for the discussion.

The presentations should be made in Microsoft's Power Point programme and brought on CD-s, DVD-s or USB.

The Poster presentations: the dimension of the poster – 140 x 100 cm.

The Official language: Serbian and English.

The accreditation will be according to the criteria of the CME program of the Serbian Medical Chamber.

The selected papers are planned to be published "in-extenso" at the supplement of the "Medical Survey", a journal that belongs to the category of the journals of the international significance (M-24).
